

Most Pet Store Puppies Come from Puppy Mills

- 99% of puppies sold in pet stores come from puppy mills.
- Nearly half of all puppies sold in pet stores are ill or incubating an illness when purchased.
- 4,500,000 puppies are born in puppy mills and sold in pet stores every year in the USA.
- There are 35,000 pet stores in America.
- Almost every puppy sold in a pet store has a mother who will spend her entire life in a tiny cage, never being petted, never being walked, never being treated like a dog, never loved.
- Female dogs are usually bred 2x a year and they are ‘used up’ by age 5, at which time they are often disposed of (killed) at the mill.
- About 1 million breeder dogs are confined in puppy mills throughout the country.
